

The examples below will give you a sense of the scholarships and financial aid packages offered by Millsaps College.

The Fall 2011-2012 Cost of Attendance for students living on campus is \$42,578. This includes tuition and fees, room and board, and indirect expenses such as books, travel, and personal expenses. The direct expenses due to Millsaps College (including tuition and fees and room and board) are \$39,794.

## Example 1

Ryan is from Pearl, Mississippi. He has a 3.75 HS GPA at Pearl High School and a 28 on the ACT. He and his parents completed the FAFSA and have an Expected Family Contribution of \$10,750.

Ryan will receive total scholarships and grants of \$23,679. This includes an \$18,000 academic scholarship, a \$500 Mississippi Tuition Assistance Grant and an additional \$5,679 in need-based grant from Millsaps College. After all Scholarships and Grants, Ryan will have a net cost of \$18,899.

In addition to the scholarships and grants, Ryan will be eligible for \$3,500 in Federal Direct Subsidized Loan and \$2,000 in Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan, and \$2,000 in Federal Perkins Loan. The total amount that Ryan will be billed by Millsaps College is \$8,615.

## Example 2

Kaylee is from Greenville, MS and attended Norma C. O'Bannon High School. She has a 3.10 HS GPA and a 24 on the ACT. She and her parents completed the FAFSA and have an Expected Family Contribution of \$36,000.

Kaylee will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$10,000 and a \$500 Mississippi Tuition Assistance Grant, resulting in a net cost of \$32,578. In addition to the scholarship, Kaylee will be eligible for \$5,500 in Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan. The total amount that Kaylee will be billed by Millsaps College is \$24,294.

## Example 3

John is from Miami Beach, FL and attended Mechina High School. He has a 3.95 HS GPA and received a 29 on the ACT. He and his parents completed the FAFSA and have an Expected Family Contribution of \$0.

John will receive total scholarships and grants of \$30,656. This includes a \$22,000 academic scholarship, \$5,550 Pell Grant and a \$700 Supplemental Equal Opportunity Grant from the federal government, and an additional \$2,406 in need-based grant from Millsaps College. After all Scholarships and Grants, John will have a net cost of \$11,922.

In addition to the scholarships and grants, John will be eligible for \$3,500 in Federal Direct Subsidized Loan and \$2,000 in Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan, and \$2,000 in Federal Perkins Loan. The total amount that John will be billed by Millsaps College is \$1,638.
